Residence permit application

- 110 euro

Schengen visa

- 90 euro

Reduced Schengen visa fees (for citizens of Albania, Azerbaijan, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Georgia, Kosovo, North Macedonia, Moldova, Montenegro, Armenia, Serbia, Ukraine)

- 35 euro

Reduced Schengen visa fee for children under 12 (citizen of Georgia)

- 0 euro

Reduced Schengen visa fee for children under 6

- 0 euro

Reduced Schengen visa fee for children 6-12 years (citizen of Azerbaijan, Turkey, Armenia)

- 0 euro

Reduced Schengen visa fee for persons under 18 (citizen of Ukraine)

- 0 euro

Schengen visa fee for family member of EEA nationals (if they are travelling together or visiting the family member)

- 0 euro

Legalisation of translation

- preparing a translation from Hungarian to Moldovan/Romanian, Russian, English: 45 euro/page
- preparing a translation from Moldovan/Romanian, Russian, English to Hungarian: 35 euro/page
- legalizing an already existing translation (from Hungarian to Moldovan/Romanian, Russian, English): 30 euro
- legalizing an already existing translation (from Moldovan/Romanian, Russian, English to Hungarian) 20 euro

Legalization of signature

- 30 euro

Legalization of a copy of a document

- 20 euro

Certificate of good character

- 0 euro + 40 euro consular fee
